### Entrepreneurship as driver of the transformation


Transformation succeeds when innovative entrepreneurship meets the right policy settings.

• In our activities, we engage visionary companies and start-ups.




# What is our theory of change?

To trigger change, we engage our target group throughout an evolutionary cycle with three phases.








#### Dr. Larissa Karthaus
